The Learn-to-Swim Teacher reports to the Head of Learn-to-Swim of Mauritius Multisport Infrastructure Limited (MMIL). Out of normal hours work and work on weekends will be required.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To teach swimming and water safety across all age-groups and a variety of programs;
- Actively and positively promotes the life skill of swimming and water safety;
- Assess students & liaises with both parents & student;
- To create and deliver lesson plans and curriculums provided, giving consistency and quality in lessons;
- Enforces ground rules, safety rules and regulations;
- Makes rescues and administers first aid when necessary;
- Responsible for preventing injuries by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations and potential dangers before they happen;
- Ensuring that the swimming pool, teaching and equipment areas are kept clean;

- Provide explanations and demonstrate swimming techniques;
- To be a positive role model, creating a positive and fun environment in which to motivate and encourage children and adults to participate in swimming;
- Teaching with encouragement and positive reinforcement;
- Communicate and engage effectively with students of all abilities, ages and cultural needs;
- Preparing, cleaning and organising of lesson areas and equipment. Maintains and ensures proper storage of all equipment;
- Responsible for obtaining and updating a valid and recognised qualification to teach swimming;
- Attend required/mandatory workshops and in-service training outside of regular working hours;
- Ensure safe provision of all equipment and ensure it is used correctly;
- Make sure safety standards are followed in sessions and undertake risk assessments;
- Work alongside the Swimming Coach, Lifeguards to help ensure that participants can swim in a safe environment;
- Assist in applying and removing the thermal pool blankets and pool cleaning robot if required;
- May be required to work across a range of Aquatic Facilities;
- To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Learn-to-Swim Teacher in the roles ascribed to him/ her.

- Physically able to teach and demonstrate all swimming skills. Able to swim at least 400m continuously, demonstrating Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Sidestroke accurately
- Physically able to teach from within the water for long periods of time.
- Physically able to assist swimmers in and out of the pool.
- Driven and passionate about all aspects of swimming and water safety.
- Knowledge of all aspects of the skills involved with this activity.
- Self-starter, able to work on your own initiative, and have a good eye for detail.
- Organizational skills

- Able to work effectively in a team
- Ability to be flexible and multi-task.
